#### **PARAMEDIC**

The Emergency Medical Sciences - Paramedic program prepares students to perform advanced emergency medical procedures in the pre-hospital setting. Students are trained in theory and a variety of technical skills. Upon completion of the program, the student is granted a Technical Certificate or an Associate of Applied Science Degree and is eligible to apply to take the National Registry EMT-Paramedic Certification Examination.

Upon passing the certification exam, graduates are licensed as Paramedics, through the Arkansas Department of Health. SEARK College graduates who complete both the Technical Certificate and Associate of Applied Science Degree programs and who pass the certification examination are able to enter a high demand field and can utilize the education received to enter programs such as Disaster Preparedness, Emergency Management or Fire Sciences.
