EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY--BASIC

Emergency Medical Sciences EMT-Basic program is an introductory survey of emergency medical services including medical legal/ethical aspects, patient assessment, care of wounds and fractures, airway maintenance, patient transportation, medical and environmental emergency, childbirth, and extrication.

The program prepares graduates for employment with ambulance services and in acute emergency facilities.

Graduates are eligible to apply to take the examination for national certification as an EMT-B.
